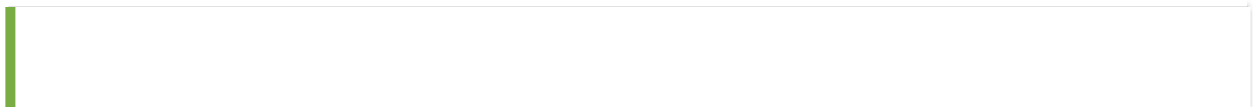

I totally enjoyed the engagement with other attendees, the variety of workshop offerings, the elements of fun during the day, and the selection of evening entertainment!

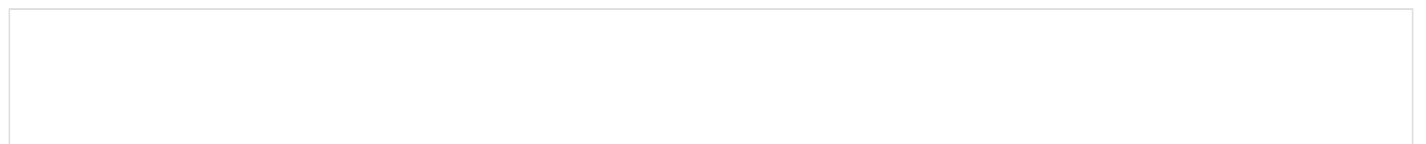
Sustainability matters and we're in it together
